## Château de Villambis "Cru Bourgeois"

is located in the region of Haut Médoc, south of the Médoc peninsula.

One of the particularity of this vineyard is the fact that it is operated by a a team of 20 handicapped workers and is a part of a program of insertion of the disabled by work.

The vineyard spreads over 15 hectares, made of sandy and gravelly soil. The average age of vineyard is 30 years.

The total annual production is **5.500 cases.** 

Vintage **2011** has been awarded in 2014 a **Gold Medal** in Paris.

After the mechanical and manual harvest, the vinification is carried out in a traditional way using stainless steel thermostatically-controlled vat. The wine is aged with 65% in oak barrels for 12 months and 35% in vat.

The wine has a beautiful red dress with a lot of highlights. The nose is discreet with notes of wood. On the palate, this wine is dense and well structured. Patience rigor to this very promising vintage.
