



LES HAUTS DE LYNCH MOUSSAS 2008 HAUT- MÉDOC

Second Wine of Château Lynch Moussas

<u>VINEYARD</u>	:	60 hectares
<u>SOIL</u>	:	clayey-chalky soil with gravels
<u>GRAPE VARIETIES</u>	:	62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 38% Merlot
<u>APPELLATION</u>	:	HAUT-MEDOC

Mr Emile and Philippe CASTEJA decided to create the second wine of Château de LYNCH MOUSSAS as from the 2001 vintage.

This manual-harvested wine received constant care and was brought up through a long vinification. It is a good introduction to the first wine LYNCH MOUSSAS.

LES HAUTS DE LYNCH MOUSSAS, whose name comes from the vineyard overhanging the estate has arisen from younger plots that could not join the ones of the main Château LYNCH MOUSSAS.

Brought up in one-wine new barrels, it reveals through tasting its **beautiful deep ruby colour, its fruity nose.**

The start is **fresh and full-bodied**, with a **significant length in the mouth.**

Can be drunk as young, but also be kept long by “connaisseurs”.
