
Domaine des Grandes Perrières

Jérôme & Frédérique Gueneau created the Domaine des Grandes Perrières in 1993. From very small beginnings, the gradually grew to meet a growing demand. It is now a little bit more than 10 ha (24 acres).

The quality of the wine is recognized by many restaurants and it is served at the table of the French prime minister.

Location: 3.11 miles north of the village of Sury en Vaux, in the Sancerre region, 125 miles south of Paris.

Terroir: Silex, clay, ferruginous soils

Age of the vines: 40 years old.

Grape varieties: 100% Pinot Noir.

Vinification: Maceration adapted to each vintage. Roughly 2-3 weeks.

Winemaker: Jérôme Gueneau

Owner: Gueneau Family

Type of ageing: In concrete vats and bottling in the spring.

Tasting note: Ruby red, clear and bright. It has a pinot nose with hints of violets and spice that makes it very pleasant.

Accompaniment advice: Often used as the wine throughout a meal, it is amazing with white meats and goat cheese.
