Many vats of the Cabernet Sauvignon are exceptional. On the nose, the wine exhibits an enticing palette of complex floral aromas, beautifully balanced by ripe fruit and mature tannins on the palate. Its generous body, classic structure and silky texture are matched by a long, satisfying finish. Overall, an elegant and stylish wine of great purity, seductive in its appeal.
