WEATHER CONDITIONS:


Winter has been quite mild to finish by an intense cold and show spring's eve.


With heavy and numerous rains during the spring, virus diseases have appeared regularly and we fought them with light adapted treatments.

Flowering appeared rather late, and lasted. The result has been millerandage and coulure which explains a reduced yield.

Second half of July, good weather arrives and a hot and dry summer took place.

Autumn rain has pushed us to harvest late all grape varietals for all our Estates.
